In Paul Miller's article "Reading Comprehension and Its Relation to the Quality of Functional Hearing: Evidence From Readers With Different Functional Hearing Abilities," (pp. 305–22) in volume 150 (3), summer issue, an error occurred in the results section (pp. 311–16). In every instance the incorrect text " $p >$ " should be replaced with " $p <$ ", except on page 313, second column, where the

phrase " $p > .08$ ns ($n = 20$)" is correct. There is an additional error on page 314, right column below Table 3, in the sentence beginning with "Seven of the hard of hearing . . ." The word "Seven" should be "Nine".
